## LOCATION

Marshall is a historic community ideally located about halfway between Detroit and Chicago, at the crossroads of I-94 and I-69. It is 10 minutes east of Battle Creek, and less than an hour from Kalamazoo, Lansing and Ann Arbor.

## LIFESTYLE

Marshall is a vibrant, tightly knit community with a high quality of life. Founded in 1830, Marshall offers a rich heritage evident by the 850 historic homes and buildings in one of the country's largest National Landmark Historic Districts. Picturesque streets, quality schools, a full menu of family-oriented events and activities and unique shops round out the town's flavorful character.

## HOSPITAL

In early 2008, Oaklawn Hospital finished its most ambitious building project ever that will result in 100% private acute care rooms. Believed to be the largest private rooms in the state, each room features leading edge technology including wall mounted bedside computers, wireless connectivity and cell phone compatibility. Vocera wireless devices provide instant communication between doctors, nurses and key staff throughout the hospital at all times. A ceiling mounted lift system enables easy patient movement to a wheel chair or other points within the room. Alcoves with computers outside each room will allow for dictation or records updates while windows allow patient observation.

For patients and family, there is ample seating for six including a comfortable sleeper and other hotel-like amenities such as oak crown molding, a desk with make-up mirror, 27" flat panel television, and a large bathroom with hair dryer.

Oaklawn Hospital is a HealthGrades Top 5% hospital for joint replacement outcomes and in 2007 received the Governor's Award for Improving Patient Safety and Quality of Care in the Hospital Setting for: Appropriate Care Measure; Surgical care Improvement; Health information Technology for CPOE.

The hospital's service area includes Marshall, Albion, Battle Creek, Homer, Tekonsha, Coldwater, Olivet, Bellevue, Charlotte and surrounding communities.
