LOCATION

Reed City is a crossroads community. It was originally at the intersection of two railroad systems that bisected the state. It is now at the crossroads of U.S. Highways 131 and 10, providing easy access to other parts of the state. The city is within an hour's drive from Grand Rapids, Traverse City and Midland. Osceola and Lake counties are "health professional shortage areas."

LIFESTYLE

The lifestyle in this small community is quiet and safe, with a good school system. There is a broad employment base and an active retail community and a nearby state university. Housing costs are lower than the metropolitan areas of the state. Tourism plays a major role in the community's economy and Reed City is a popular area for campers, hunters, fishermen, bikers, snowmobilers and boaters.

HOSPITAL

Spectrum Health Reed City Hospital has adopted the Planetree Model of health care delivery, a model of patient-centered care in a healing environment. The facility is one of about 300 nationwide that has adopted this unique level of caregiving.

The comprehensive cancer care center at the Crossroads Radiation Therapy Center offers a beautiful, rural setting for its personalized approach to cancer care. Nearly 40 percent of West Michigan adults and nearly 90 percent of children seek cancer care at Spectrum Health. More than 800 of these patients continue their care in Reed City.
