LOCATION

Located in the lakeshore community of Grand Haven, Michigan, North Ottawa Community Health System serves Northern Ottawa County including Grand Haven, Spring Lake, Ferrysburg, West Olive, Fruitport and Nunica.

LIFESTYLE

The Grand Haven area is an active and eclectic resort, boating, fishing and port community that maintains a small town feel. The city boasts over 100 miles of bike trails, a state beach, boardwalk, 2 lighthouses, a pier, wharf, and a large charter fishing fleet.

Grand Haven State Park was nationally recognized for having one of the top 5 beaches in the United States, by Good Morning America - Travel Mom. The state park also includes a campground on Lake Michigan, near the pier and lighthouses. In addition, the city features a ski park (Mulligan's Hollow Ski Bowl) and a skate park. Grand Haven is also home to one of the country's most beautiful golf courses. The Grand Haven Golf Club has been featured in Sports Illustrated, Golf Digest magazines and on USA Network's "PGA Tour Sunday."

Grand Haven has been a technology leader in West Michigan and holds the title as first municipality in the country to feature a city-wide wireless internet service. The wireless service is designed to work throughout the city and up to 15 miles offshore for boaters.
