LOCATION

Pine Rest Christian Mental Health Services' main campus is located 10 miles south of downtown Grand Rapids on US-131 in Cutlerville. Patients seeking care receive inpatient/partial hospitalization; outpatient; residential treatment for adolescent boys and girls; residential services for persons with developmental disabilities; residential services for persons having dementia; and services for drug and alcohol addictions.

Pine Rest's outpatient services are located at over 20 additional locations. These include Muskegon, Grand Haven, Holland, Zeeland, Traverse City, Greenville, Rockford, Grandville, Walker, Wyoming, Grand Rapids, Caledonia, Lake Odessa, Hastings and Kalamazoo.

LIFESTYLE

The communities where Pine Rest's outpatient clinics are located, as well as the area where its main campus is located, offer scenic, family-oriented activities for year 'round fun. Major entertainment, museum, sports, dining, church, and youth organizational facilities abound in each community.

AREA EMPLOYERS
