LOCATION

Lakeland HealthCare includes three hospitals in St. Joseph, Niles, and Berrien Center. All Lakeland sites are located within Berrien County, in Michigan's southwest corner. Driving east on I-80/90 or I-94, Berrien County is just 60 miles from Chicago.

LIFESTYLE

Southwest Michigan is a year-round destination, thanks to the area's pristine Lake Michigan beaches, rolling orchards and vineyards, and charming shopping and dining districts. Recreational opportunities abound, from cross-country skiing in county and state parks, to boating along the lakefront and down the St. Joseph River. The region is home to a number of colleges and universities, including Andrews University, Lake Michigan College, and Southwestern Michigan College.

HOSPITAL

Lakeland HealthCare is a not-for-profit, community-owned health system, which includes three hospitals, an outpatient surgery center, rehabilitation services and long-term care. The history of Lakeland dates back to the 1800s, when the hospitals first began meeting the needs of southwest Michigan residents. Today, they are proud to continue that tradition of service to the community with excellent, compassionate care.

As a part of their mission to provide high-quality, high-value, compassionate healthcare services, they work to continuously improve the quality of the services they provide. Lakeland benchmarks their care against national standards to assess how they are performing, to make sure they are providing their patients with the best possible healthcare services.

Lakeland offers the newest imaging technologies, including PET/CT scanning, 64-slice CT scanning, and advanced MRI in a totally digital environment, including breast MRI.

The Heart Center at Lakeland Regional Medical Center, St. Joseph serves as a training site that teaches cardiologists from around the Midwest about advanced procedures for peripheral vascular disease. The training program allows physicians to gain the skills necessary under the supervision of highly skilled, experienced Lakeland specialists. Lakeland Regional Medical Center, St. Joseph, is one of only 20 sites in the nation offering the training, and one of only two in Michigan. Lakeland will begin offering student rotation opportunities in the fall of 2008 and launch a residency program in conjunction with Michigan State University in the fall of 2009.

Lakeland has more than 3,000 employees who provide clinical and support services at several locations throughout Southwest Michigan, and is the county's largest employer.
